





## Q5 - Do you currently accept and dispose of unused or expired medications?





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
Participate in two or three yearly events. No longer able to mail in collected items, they now have to drive them to Omaha and hand them in in person, so it takes more time and funding than it used to.



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


### Additional Comments



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
Send 20 lb drums back to the DEA when full, they do not pay for this service
